## CHANGES TO DIVISION OF PLACES ON COMMITTEES

## REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE OFFICER

## Purpose of Report

To provide an explanation behind the changes to the division of places on Standing Committees, Sub Committees, Task \& Finish Working Groups and Partnerships, and to advise Members as to how these committees may be reinstated.

## Background

Following the co-option of Councillor Errawalla and Councillor Parvaiz at the Full Council meeting held on 7 February 2023, the political composition of the Council changed. This change has impacted the division of places on committees with a Councillor membership of 3,5 or 9 Members.

## Committees of 9 Members

Based on normal mathematical rounding, the Liberal Democrat Group are now only entitled to one place on committees with a membership of 9 Councillors, when previously this was two. However, this would mean only 8 places are allocated to such committees, one less than it should be. As such, the Strategy \& Resources, Leisure Services, and Planning \& Community Committees are not currently viable in line with proportionality rules.

## Committees of 5 Members

Based on normal mathematical rounding, the Conservative Group are now entitled to an additional place on committees with a membership of 5 Councillors. However, this means the number of places allocated would be 6, one more than it should be. As such, such committees are not currently viable in line with proportionality rules.

## Committees of 3 Members

Based on normal mathematical rounding, the Liberal Democrat Group are now not entitled to a place on committees with a membership of 3 Councillors, when previously they were entitled to one place. However, this would mean only 2 places are allocated to such committees, one less than it should be. As such, such committees are not currently viable in line with proportionality rules.
